

# 2024 Scholarship Program

### 5 Scholarships Available!

Mauriceville Heritage Association announces the 2024 *Scholarship Awards Program. A total of 5, \$1,000.00 Scholarships are available.* Under the Program, five (5) \$1,000.00 scholarships will be awarded to seniors/co-enrolled high school students or 1st-year college students who have resided in the following school districts: LCM CISD, West Orange ISD, Bridge City ISD, Orangefield ISD, Deweyville ISD, and Vidor ISD. Applicants may have been homeschooled, but must meet the residency guidelines. One \$1,000.00 scholarship with NO RESIDENCY restrictions is available if the student or student's parent has volunteered specifically for the Mauriceville Heritage Association. If no applicants apply who have volunteered or parents have volunteered for the MHA, that scholarship will fall under the above outlined requirements. The MHA reserves the right to restrict the number of scholarships given depending on the number and merit of applicants.

### Available Scholarships:

<u>Orange County, TX</u>: Five (5) \$1,000 scholarships are available in Orange County for seniors attending any high school in Orange County.

# **Program Guidelines & Priorities:**

- \* Seeking graduating seniors with a record of volunteerism in the community in non-school sponsored activities and participation in extracurricular school activities.
- \* Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and plan to attend a 2 or 4-year college OR technical school.
- \* Scholarship funds will be paid **directly to the college** and not to the student. It will be the student's responsibility to submit to the Association at that time an invoice for semester tuition and fees, student ID number, and college information.
- \* Applicants are encouraged to have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor or school official on their application attesting they are a qualified fit for this scholarship program. *Mauriceville Heritage Association strongly suggests that each high school present this opportunity to the strongest applicants that match this program's guidelines. The application deadline is <u>April 15, 2024</u>, either postmarked or handed to a board member. Late applications are not accepted. Deadline adherence will be based on postmark/ board member signature.*
